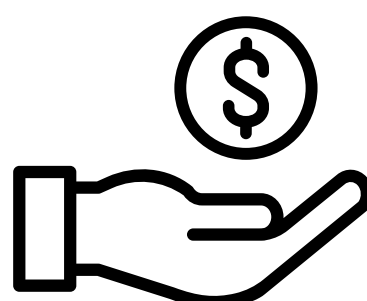

NATIONAL PLAN FOR MUSIC EDUCATION

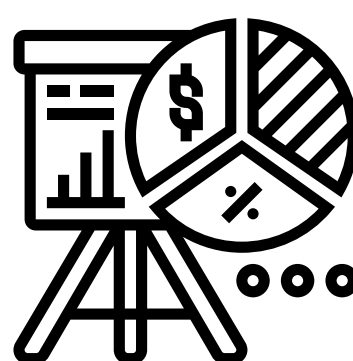
FINANCES

£79 million will be made available every year until 2025 for the Music Hubs programme.



LESSONS

Every pupil to have at least one hour per week of high-quality music education in key stages 1-3.



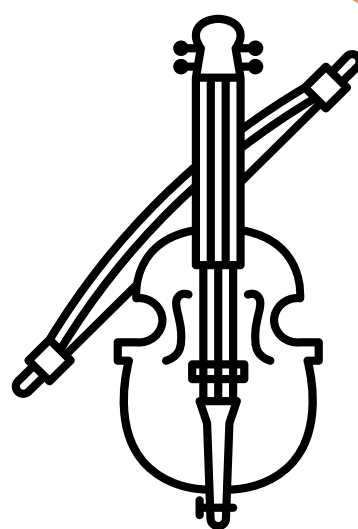
DEVELOPMENT

Pilot to improve music progression in disadvantaged areas and the roll-out of an inclusion strategy in every music hub area.



INSTRUMENT ACCESS

£25 million for schools to purchase musical instruments and equipment, including adapted instruments for pupils with special educational needs and disabilities.
